STUDENT LOAN CRITERIA

The Rotary Club of Jackson has student loans available to assist with the achievement of educational goals. The loan is up to a maximum of \$1500.00 per application. The loan is available to either single or married students.

Repayment shall begin six months after graduation or two months after withdrawal from school. Interest on the loan is waived if graduation occurs or vocational training is completed.

The applicant must:

1. Be a resident of Amador County.
2. Have completed one year of college or 50% of vocational training.
3. Submit a letter of application that includes proof of school enrollment, future goals and three references (one may be a relative).
4. Name of Jackson Rotarian who will be the sponsor.

The Student Loan Committee will evaluate all applications. Students will be contacted if further information is necessary.

The decision of the Committee will be referred to the Rotary Board of Directors for approval. The student will be notified of the decision and if approved will be asked to sign a note agreeing to repay the loan.
